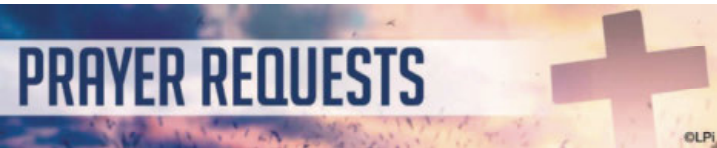

The Labor Union which had arisen within the People's Party had one day organized a party with a charity booth. Instead I spent three lire and I feel as if I had spent ten..." Pier Giorgio delicately inquired as to the reason for the expense, then, after a moment of pretend distraction, he resumed his conversation: "Look, I had to go to the Workers' Union to buy a ticket for a friend of mine... If you sell me yours, you'll save me the road and you the shopping." The young worker's adherence was, understandably, enthusiastic, and on the other hand Pier Giorgio's proposal had been so quick and clear that he hadn't left the other time to think about his real motive.
