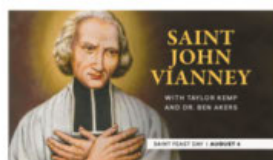
Ignatius of Loyola

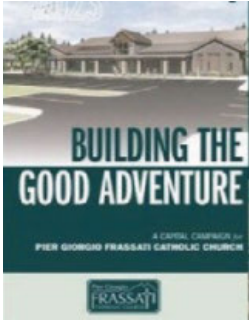

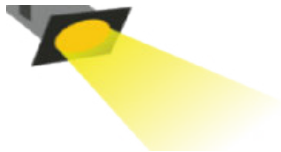

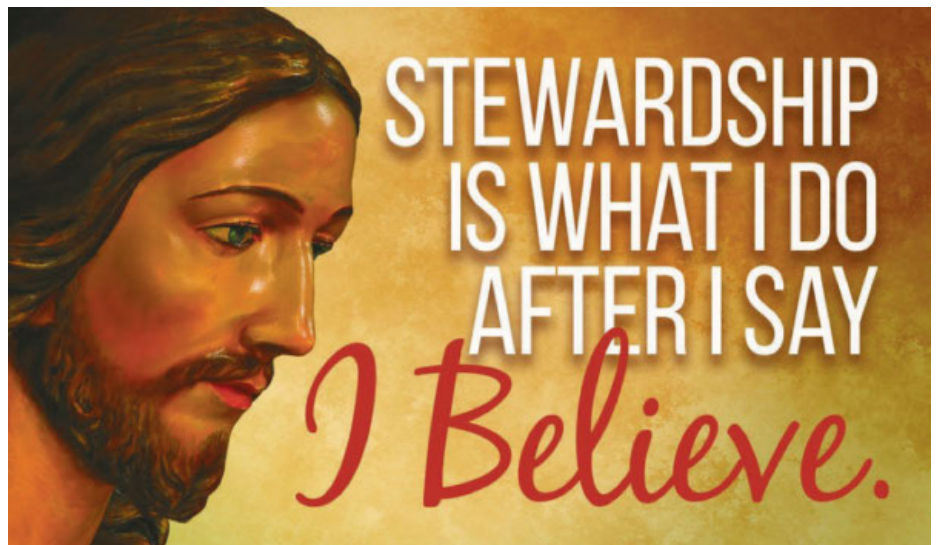
