Giuseppe Gindro was the son of our doorkeeper. And every time that he met Pier Giorgio they were gigantic greetings. Usually this happened early in the morning, when Giuseppe went to work and Pier Giorgio returned from Mass. Pier Giorgio's voice resounded as loud as the shot of a firecracker exuberant with joy and happiness. But as he grew up over the years and began associating with men, Giuseppe Gindro began to understand how difficult it was to find people capable of treating the son of their porter as a brother and a friend.


