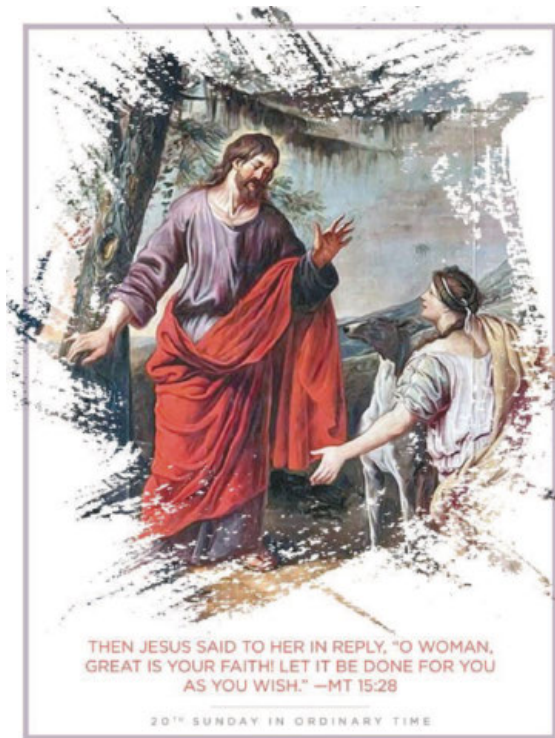

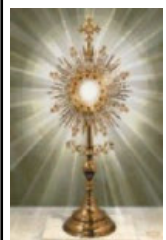

She knew nothing, and only after his death, when her neighbors told her that someone who helped so many people and helped her too had died, did she ask and obtain to see his photograph and she recognized him. It was he, really him, who had helped her buy back a pair of earrings from the pawnshop and who had even brought them back to her in a little box. It was he who bought back the dress that still hangs in her closet today: he, always he who presented the ribbon when she wanted to have her youngest child confirmed. And the ribbon wasn't enough, he also gave her a new little dress. Pier Giorgio did a lot for Luisa Angiolillo, and there is no evening that Luisa Angiolillo does not remember him in her prayers as an eighty-year-old woman. 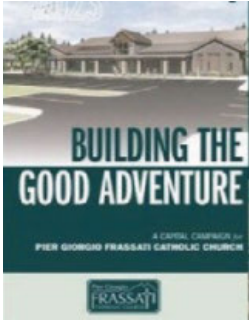

Tithe for August 27 – Horry County Literary Council (HCLC)

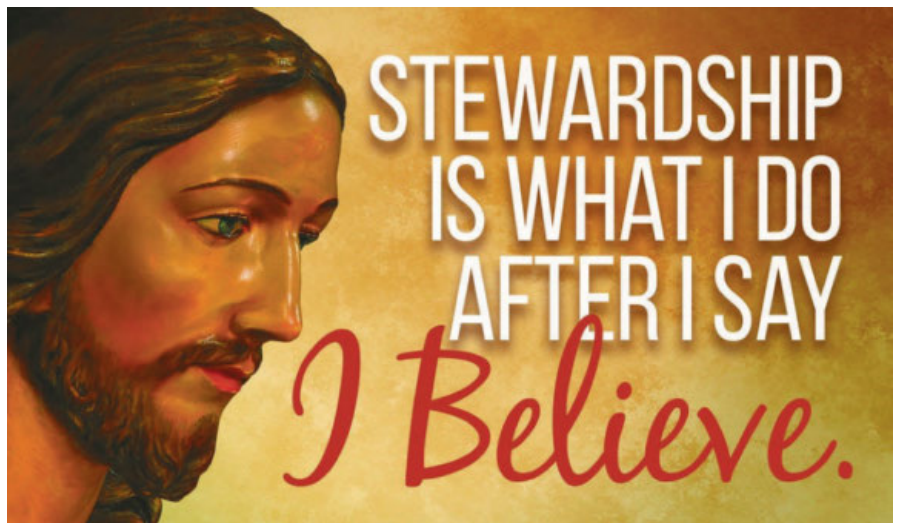
