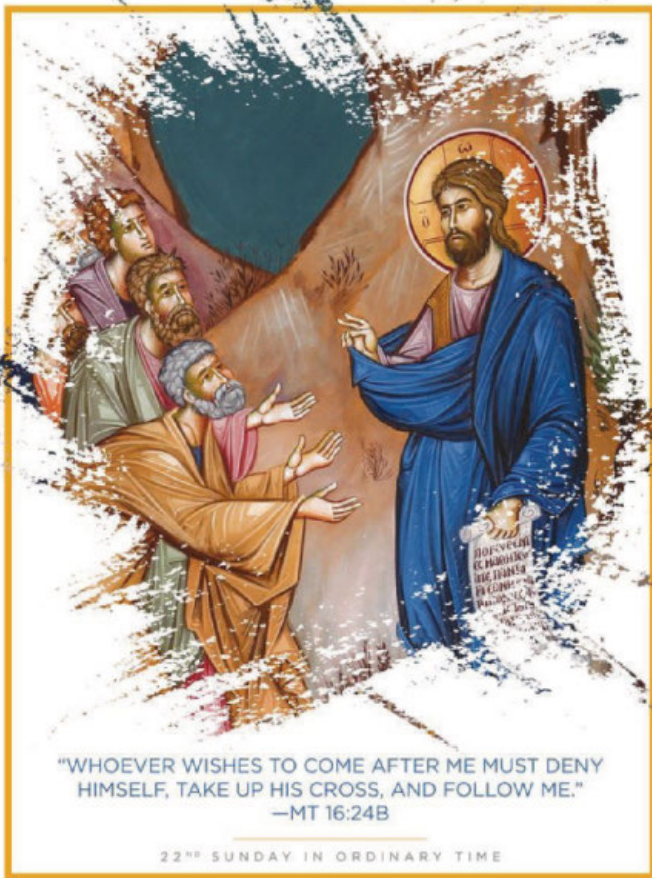

A ringing at the door of Jole Girardi's house. It's Severi and Pier Giorgio who go to see the young lady's mother to ask her for a favor: one of their usual favors. This time it is for a large family, very limited in means, which they have managed to accommodate in a rented room. Naturally, it is Pier Giorgio who pays the rent, taking out the lire one by one from his own pockets. Naturally, it is Pier Giorgio who procures the medicines for one of the children who has fallen ill. Now they ask Jole Girardi's mother for one thing: to help them in a work of moral charity; to help them resolve the sad and shameful position of one of the girls of the miserable family, who lives in Rome illegally united with a rich gentleman. As is understandable, the action and words of Pier Giorgio cannot influence the situation too much, especially since the mother of the unfortunate girl must be convinced to call her daughter home or to have her legalize the illicit relationship, two extremely difficult things. Jole Girardi's mother agrees to come to the aid of the family and, why not, to the two young people and decides to go with them to visit those poor people the next day. The appointment is set. Jole Girardi is also enthusiastic. She too wants to do something and manages to convince her mother to take her with her. So all is well. Tomorrow at the Carabinieri Monument. But Signora Girardi remembers that Pier Giorgio had asked her something else as he entered. She remembers that he promised a set of clothing and linens for a newborn to another family, and that he recommended it to her. *(Excerpts from **La Carità**, edited by Luciana Frassati)*

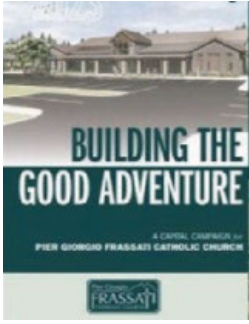

Tithe for September 10 – Home Works of America

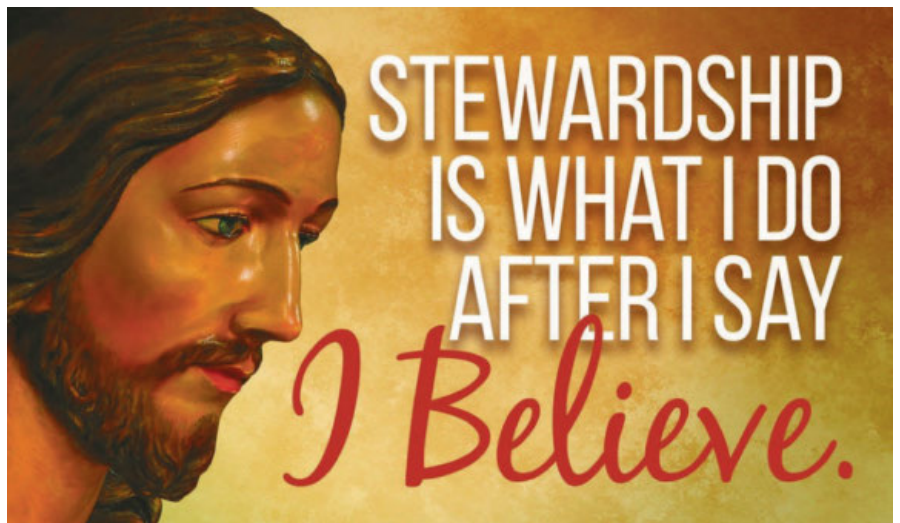
