

NEWS & EVENTS

Frassati Catholic Church will be having a Life Chain on October 1st from 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm in front of Seton School on Carolina Forest Blvd. It is a time to stand in peaceful, prayerful public witness along-Chain side other local believers. Come join us!

Beginning October 5th, the weekday Thursday Mass will permanently move from 7pm to 5:30 pm. This means that it will precede (not follow) our weekly opportunity for Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions that take place Thursdays from 6-7 pm. This decision has been made for the following reasons:

- To bring our weekday Mass opportunities into greater rhythm and harmony, as all of our weekday Masses (Mon, Wed, Thur, Fri) will begin at 5:30 pm.
- The celebration of various Solemnities on Thursdays has prompted us to move the Mass on those days to 5:30 pm and to cancel Eucharistic Adoration because of the added length of time. This has prompted confusion for those who don't follow our bulletin news and/or are visiting Myrtle Beach.
- With Mass & Eucharistic Adoration finished at 7 pm, we will begin adding some other social & discipleship events starting at 7 pm Thursdays.
- With the end of Daylight Savings Time in November, some of our elderly parishioners stop coming to this Thursday Evening Mass due to safety (i.e., driving in the dark).






