## We tithe as a Parish!

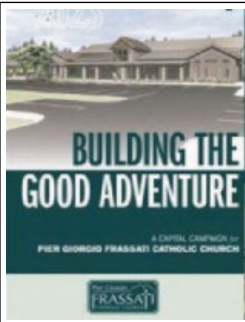
