



Felice Dieni was in a moment of desolation. Misery and dejection were progressively destroying him. He was determined to commit suicide when he felt a hand resting on his shoulder: it was Pier Giorgio's hand. To allay his anxieties it was enough for Pier Giorgio to speak to him with his voice, with his everyday words, and for him to show so much interest in saving a derelict soul and protecting a body already condemned to eternal silence.




