



His personal charity was not enough for him, he also wanted others to accompany him in depriving themselves of everything to give it to the poor. When Father Ercole Provera went out with Pier Giorgio and tried to take the tram because he felt tired, he heard an unchanged response: "Come on, look at this poor man, let's give him what we have. And then it means I'll take care of his tram." There was no way of using a means of transport when you were with him, and there was no way of even having a drink. When Father Provera was thirsty, he said, "Pier Giorgio, I am terribly thirsty", but the other immediately with the usual smile responded: "Let's give to a poor man what we would spend, and so the thirst passes!"
