

# FRASSATI SPOTLIGHT—WHAT IS OUR MISSION?

Our Mission at Frassati Catholic Church is "Preparing disciples for the good adventure." What does this mean? We recognize that everyone is at different stages of their climb-verso l'altotowards the heights - towards heaven. Some are discerning the costs of beginning it for them and those they love. Others have stopped, fallen, or become sidetracked, due to noise, apathy, or wounds. Still others are actively engaged in the climb of their life. Finally, some have made it "to the top" and now are interceding and helping us. Regardless, we seek as a family to meet each person where they are at and help them climb that next phase of the mountain of the Lord with the tools that our Catholic faith has developed over two millennia. Moreover, we strive to do it "Frassati style," i.e., in and with the spirit of our patron, whom was dubbed "the Man of the Beatitudes." Pier Giorgio didn't view the Beatitudes (and our Catholic faith) as just some private or passive blessing to be received, but as a call to get up, go out, live, and diffuse far and wide what has been received from God. As he once wrote, "'Jesus comes to me every morning in Holy Communion and I repay him in my very miserable way by visiting His poor." The Spanish word for "beatitude" (bienaventuranza) beautifully captures this call to action. It's a compound word (bien + aventura) that literally means "good adventure". This speaks to the nature of the journey we are on together and our desire to be the family of the beatitudes - the family of "good adventures." We seek to rise and embark daily, with the hope that those we help and serve along the way will in time step up and help others do the same with the love of Jesus.




