

Marco Beltramo tells the story: One day in 1923, while we were going up the via Po, we met a drunk in front of the Rossini theatre that bumped Pier Giorgio. I immediately gave him two punches and threw him to the ground. The poor man was not hurt by the punches but by the fall and Pier Giorgio immediately rushed to help him, picking him up and scolding me. Then he downright demanded that we accompany him to a pharmacy to give a cordial to him, while he was concerned with taking the name, surname, and address of the wretched man,
