



Marco Beltramo tells the story: In the library of the Faculty of Mathematics he [Pier Giorgio] always arrived breathless and hot. As soon as he began to take a breath, sheets of paper, packed with names and addresses of poor people to help or visit, came out of his pockets and folders one after another. Frequently Camilla Mesturini, seeing him scan those notes, was struck by his thoughtful and slightly sad attitude, how he regretted not having been able to accomplish all that he had set out to do that day. And in fact, to anyone who knew him even a little, Pier Giorgio gave the impression that there was never enough time for the too many tasks of his young age. Time was a moment in his life of only twenty-four years.

Since 2008, teams from the Diocese of Charleston has sent medical personnel and other support volunteers to spend one week serving the health needs of the poor in Guatemala. Because the needs of the people in San Pedro La Laguna are so great, the Diocese has developed a sponsorship program called Project San Pedro to serve the medical needs and the educational, nutritional and housing needs of those who are impoverished. This tithe is an opportunity for those who cannot personally go on a week-long medical mission to participate in missionary activity.
