

It was on a trip to Rocca Sella in the Val di Susa, and bound together by rope the FUCI' friends were attempting an easy wall, as a rock climbing school exercise. Elisa Reyneri was actually trying an exercise in mountaineering skills when, to reliver her of all fatigue, Pier Giorgio's steady and strong arms lifted her like a twig to the top. But in carrying out the operation, one of Pier Giorgio's fingers was scraped between the rope and rock. He didn't pay much attention to it. However, since his friends, one after the other, urged him to have it treated, taking advantage of the presence among them of a war nurse like Elisa Reyneri, he decided to extend his arm towards his friend sitting just above him. At the end of the operation, after spring water and denatured alcohol: He said, "Thank you," but the young lady jokingly protested to him: "It's not enough to say thank you. One should offer 'to repay the good." In the meantime, everyone naturally hastened to join that peculiar suggestion from their mutual friend, in the hope of receiving something. "Of course, very well," they shouted in chorus, "and there will be sweets, ice creams, chocolates of your choice for everyone!"

And Pier Giorgio, calm and serene, said: "Okay, I will pay: it will mean that whoever goes
