

It was a weekday, a little before noon and Matilde Eiche, our housekeeper, having heard the ring, opened the door to a poor man. She left him just outside yet ran into the kitchen to look for something to give him; but when she returned offering something to eat she heard the man reply: "Thank you, miss, but I don't come to beg for a piece of bread. I would like to speak to Mr. Frassati to get a job." At that moment, Matilde Eiche, taken with compassion for the stranger, didn't really know how to respond, and after a bit of hesitation she let him sit in the lobby. Pier Giorgio, as a child, returned home from school shortly afterwards and immediately asked: "Matilde, what does that man who is in the entrance want?" "He wants to talk to your dad, he doesn't have a job," was the reply. He looked sadly at the poor man from the crack of the door, then returned to the maid's work room and said: 'You know, Matilde, my dad is good, dad will give him work." As soon as she recognized our father's typical ringing, that time Matilde quickly ran to open the door and Pier Giorgio followed her waiting for what would happen. Quickly the maid explained to the father that a man wanted to talk to him. But then, suddenly the storm broke out: the father, irritated, opened the door of the house and sent the man away very forcefully, almost yelling at him that he could go to La Stampa [his newspaper] but not come to pester him with business matters at home. Pier Giorgio, who had heard and seen everything, burst into tears and said: 'Daddy is wicked.' And our father, who could not see him cry for such a reason and who had heard him cry: "Perhaps Jesus has passed by and we have chased him away" gave him a lira to give to the poor man. Pier Giorgio flew after the man to bring him the coin, and when he returned home his face was radiant even if it was still wet with tears, which finished drying when, at the table, dad assured him that he would ask for information and get the stranger a job.
