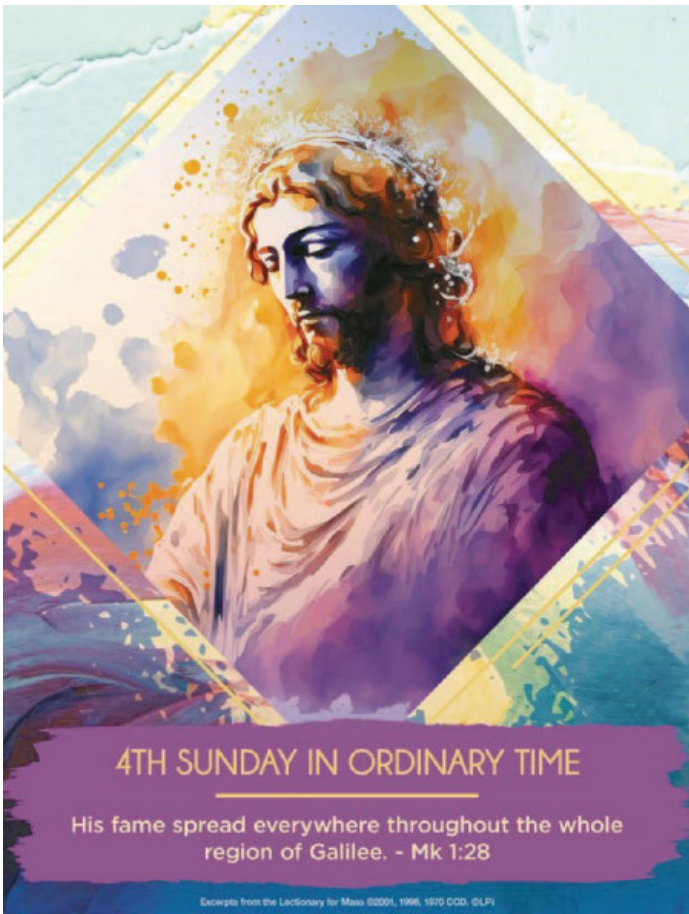

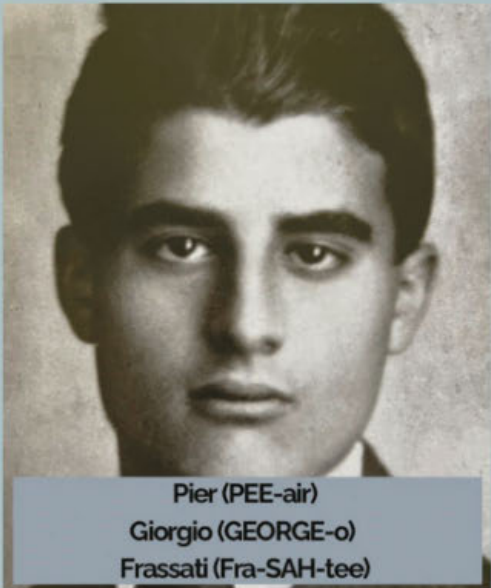

## EXCERPTS FROM LA CARITÀ,

EDITED BY LUCIANA FRASSATI



Pier (PEE-air)  
Giorgio (GEORGE-o)  
Frassati (Fra-SAH-tee)

The following episode, reported by Carlotta Volante, evidences the intensity with which Pier Giorgio, since childhood, sensed the problems of charity; how he devoted himself to them with a fervor and candor which even then revealed in him a nature superior to that of his peers and many, not to mention all, the so-called "grown-ups." Behold the episode:

"My son Franco, who was very friendly with Pier Giorgio, one day went to breakfast at the Frassati house. Pier Giorgio was about 12-13 years old and the topic fell on the poor (it must be said, as the Piedmontese say, that Pier Giorgio had the "spot"—obsession—of charity). Pier Giorgio was saying that to have a lot of money, you had to grow many flowers in Alassio, and then sell them in Turin for the benefit of the needy. To which Franco replied: "Oh yeah with what the trip costs!" His father Alfredo intervened and it was precisely because of this answer that my son was very pleased, that I was made aware of the conversation: "Well done, Franco, you have more practical sense than Pier Giorgio." Pier Giorgio reflected and then added: "But we can go on foot or by bicycle."

**Discipleship Challenge:** The New Year is upon us. To see changes, you have to make changes. If there's a relationship that you want to improve or a habit you want to develop, lamenting the current situation can help identify the need for change, but without action, the current situation will remain. 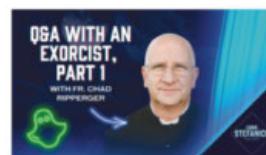

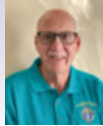
