

Pier (PEE-air) Giorgio (GEORGE-o) Frassati (Fra-SAH-tee) Thanks to his religion lessons. Don Borla lived next door to Pier Giorgio. It cannot be said for this that he really penetrated his human and religious spirit, but certainly, however, he knew a good part of his environment, relationships, friends, and companions. Therefore we must believe him when he says that Pier Giorgio was generous with material and moral help to his companions, opening his purse and helping them by paying their university fees, opening his heart to them, giving good advice and pointing out good books. In fact, his communion with his friend reached the ultimate limit of material equality, and if there were spiritual differences, his goodness meant that others, at least in his presence, would get better. Therefore one could not approach him without the overwhelming influence of his charity making itself felt. And his company therefore was welcome and sought after.

Frassati Challenge: Reflect on how in spite of religious or political differences you can still have a positive and holy influence on others.


