



There was a trip planned, and our mother gave Pier Giorgio the money for the trip. Often more than necessary, sometimes just that Iwhich was needed! Invariably, then, his great battle began. From the moment he put the money in his pocket, until he returned home, dead tired but cheerful and satisfied, he persisted in mentally organizing his expenses so that they left over money for his poor. However, my mother never managed to get the receipts from him: there was always something wrong and the sums didn't add up. And there wasn't a trip that didn't find him absolutely penniless in the end: either he had paid for someone's train ticket or a meal or a stay at a hotel. In short, his money belonged to everyone and the greatest proof came when he left for a trip to Germany with a decent sum, including occasional and budgeted alms, he returned home without even a lira: indeed, with only a lira.






