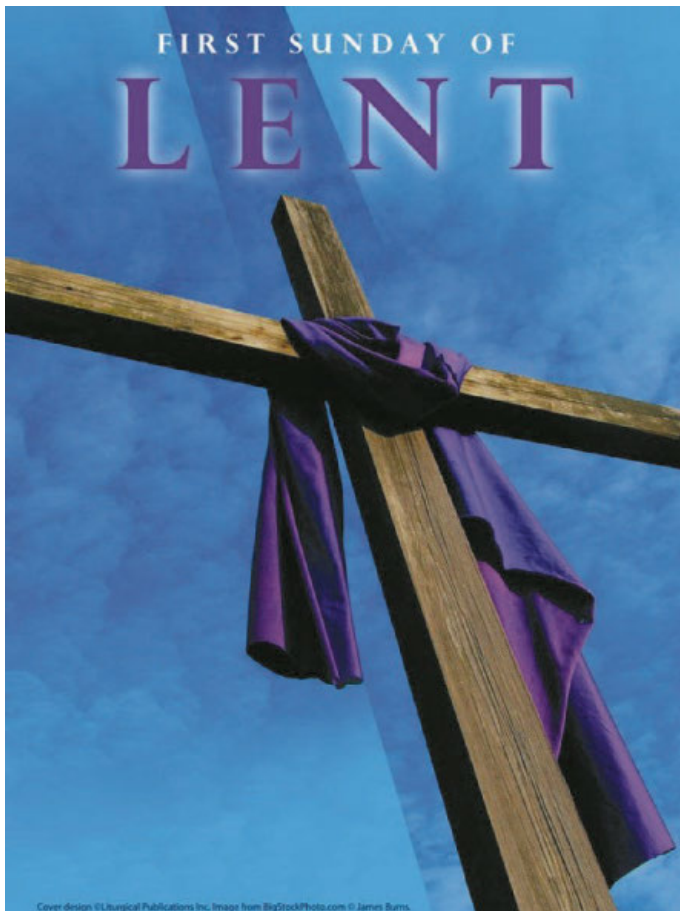

EDITED BY LUCIANA FRASSATI

Certain circles of the Catholic world, Mario Mazzarelli notes sadly, were pleased to have captured Senator Frassati's son, without reflecting that God and not earthly forces had conquered Pier Giorgio's soul. Proof of this is, if nothing else, the fact that he has continuously nourished his religious strength with charity, leaving aside any bigotry. And on this path he was certainly a man of charity: above all a man of charity, who knew how to live it intensely and profoundly, conducting his own spirit with instinctive wisdom on the difficult track of consecration to the good of others. Mario Mazzarelli himself had very effective direct and indirect proof of what was the authentic substance of Pier Giorgio's spirit and he will never be able to forget the times he went up to his house to talk a little with him and with his father, a lawyer at Cottolengo, of the poor and of assistances, perhaps asking for a recommendation as a modest compensation for the very many that he had asked of him.

Frassati Challenge: Do a conscious act of charity, not for your own ego or enjoyment or for recognition, but for God and on behalf of the mystical Body of Christ, the Church.

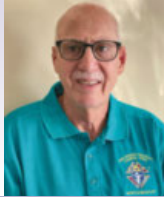

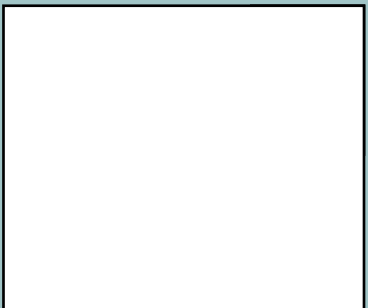
