





Fasting and Abstinence during Lent - Catholics age 14 and older should not eat meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent, including Good Friday. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics age 18 to 59 also fast. Only one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, are eaten. Exemption is allowed for pregnant women and those who need regular meals for medical reasons.

PRAYER, FASTING and ALMSGIVING. How will you prepare this **Lenten** season for the Resurrection of the Lord, Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday?

Our Lady's Pantry at Catholic Charities in Conway is low and in need of the following items to stock the pantry:

Food items: Canned vegetables, canned fruit, canned beans (baked beans, pork and beans, black eyed peas), snacks (granola/snack bars, chips, cookies), jelly, macaroni and cheese, Ensure and Boost.

Breakfast items/Baking items: Cereal, oatmeal, juice, pop tarts, grits, pancake mix. Cake, muffins and cookie mixes. Meals: Ramen noodles, canned ravioli and spaghetti, hamburger helper, Spam, etc.
