

Carlo Florio tells the story: I have a recollection of a visit to old Sasso, a poor man in very shabby health who as soon as he saw Pier Giorgio began to complain about his ailments and particularly of certain weakness in the legs which forced him to lead a sedentary life. Then, to cheer him up, Pier Giorgio began to joke and to say that the old Sasso could very well have run, even beaten Pier Giorgio himself, if he just accepted a challenge to race in the courtyard. And he knew how to joke and laugh so much that in the end the old Sasso forgot all his ailments and became cheerful like him, to the point of trying to implement the unique proposal.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics age 18 to 59 also fast. Only one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, are eaten. Exemption is allowed for pregnant women and those who need regular meals for medical reasons.
