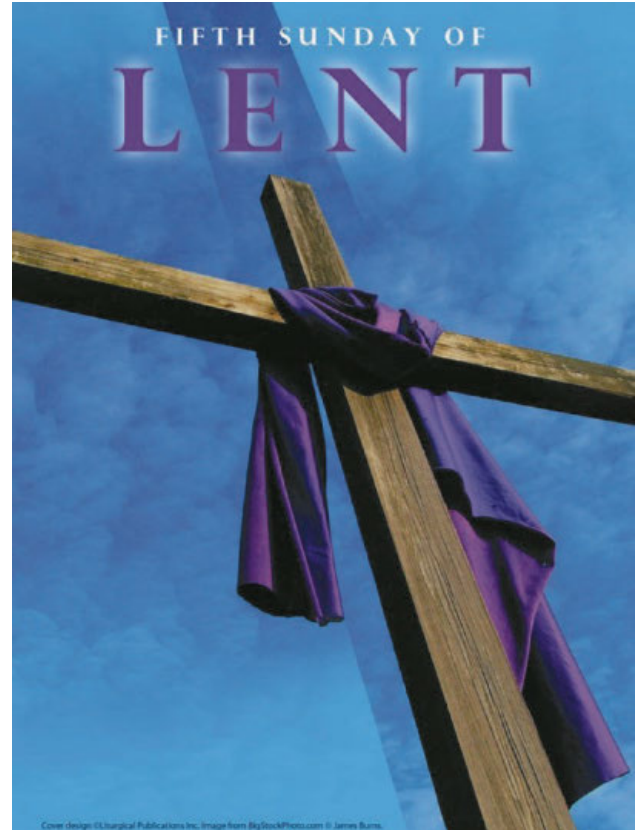


Young Adult Pilgrimage Summer 2024:

"But I don't have money for the tram," Pier Giorgio immediately responded. All of it was gone, all of it had been surrendered to the hands of his poor - the little they gave him at home. But this time a fortune came out of it. Because luck called Antonio Cellerino to offer him a ride on the tram that day.

Fasting and Abstinence during Lent - Catholics age 14 and older should not eat meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent, including Good Friday. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics age 18 to 59 also fast. Only one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, are eaten. Exemption is allowed for pregnant women and those who need regular meals for medical reasons.



As a reminder, during Lent we do not sing the **Gloria** or **Alleluia** at Mass.
