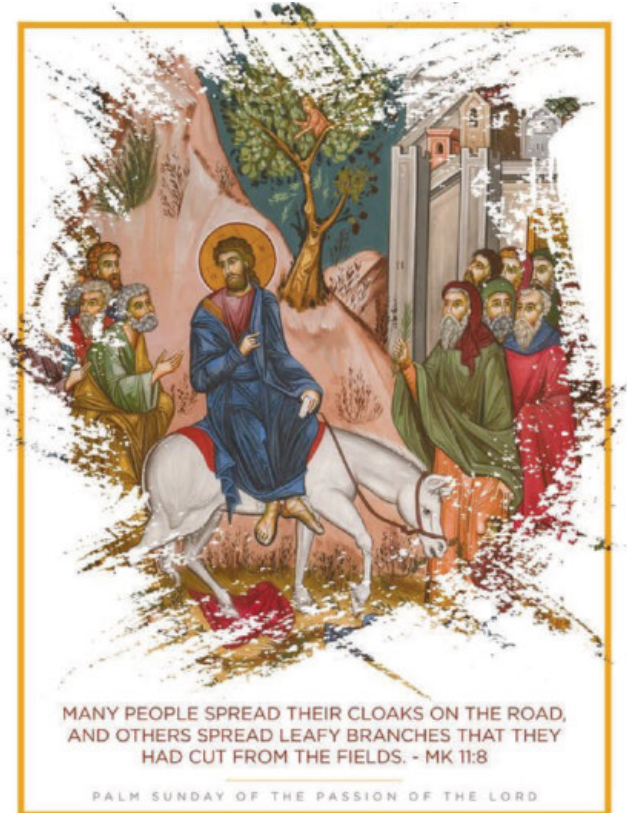

We do Faith Formation differently at Frassati Catholic Church. Our goal is to help you respond to the call to be a disciple of Jesus - someone who surrenders to Christ and seeks to live his or her life imitating Him.

Family Discipleship. As we enter Holy Week, let us reflect on these words of Jesus: "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me." When life is a struggle, we have many opportunities to take up our cross daily. But when things are going well, that's when practices of self-denial help us follow Jesus. In resisting our desires, we remember that God's will is more important than our own, and we profess it through our actions. We build spiritual strength through these small actions, whether it's washing the dishes when we're really tired, spending time with someone in need when we're running late, or refraining from taking a second cookie. Every good deed can be done for the glory of God. **Discipleship Challenge:** Spend the week carrying your cross by doing all your work and chores without complaint and with a spirit of prayer.

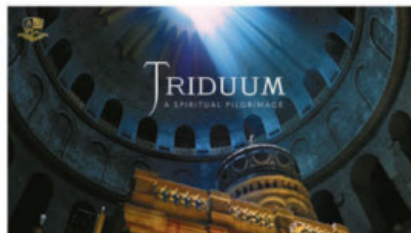

Triduum: A Spiritual Pilgrimage



Carlo Florio tells the story: Often among the most significant memories concerning Pier Giorgio are certain words caught on the fly, certain phrases seemingly without importance, that after some time reveal a depth and almost exceptional sorrow, "When one day I'm older and able to be in command, I will do as Cottolengo did. I will want to help all the poor and the children that live in need." He said this to Ester Pignata, a maid in our house, in the very last months of his life."

Fasting and Abstinence during Lent - Catholics age 14 and older should not eat meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent, including Good Friday. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics age 18 to 59 also fast. Only one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, are eaten. Exemption is allowed for pregnant women and those who need regular meals for medical reasons.



As a reminder, during Lent we do not sing the **Gloria** or **Alleluia** at Mass.
