

#### FRASSATI SPOTLIGHT – ALTAR LINENS

## Social Communications Survey Results

A special thanks to all 162 responders (20% of households) to our google survey form.

**Bulletin Data:** Of the responders, 98% read it and 1 in 5 read it online. National studies suggest that the bulletin is the least effective way to reach disengaged Catholics. 77% of responders typically find the information they need in it. Announcements and Upcoming Events dominated what was "most important" to them overall. Info about our patron ranked at 31% for "most important" and 38% for "least important" suggesting an interesting cross-section between parishioners when it comes to their desire to learn more about Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. Two in three know what a QR code is and find them helpful at least some time.

**Improvements coming down the pipeline:** more structure and conciseness, less clutter, clearer ministry needs and objectives, updates on the building of the parish campus, a preview of the upcoming week events on the front page, better picture resolution, increased font size, less diocesan announcements. There were a good number of responders requesting less repetition. Although we are fine-tuning the parameters for the timing of announcements, we will not likely satisfy the request for "less repetition" because the reality is that most people are less engaged than our responders. Many people travel, don't come on a weekly basis, or do not utilize all forms of social communications which necessitates repetition. Note: The parish distributes 525-550 bulletins a week. Moreover, printing the bulletin costs the parish nothing, and we are permitted seven pages given the publishing company sells advertisements.

**Social Media Data:** Of the responders, 50% follow the parish online. National studies suggest that beyond personal invitations, social media is the way to best engage the disengaged. Hence, one of the reasons a new initiative between our parish and FrassatiUSA has begun to create a new social media community to invite Frassati-lovers in the English speaking world to share in our parish's mission and vision. In the next couple months, we will be closing the Catholic Community at Carolina Forest (Facebook group page) and solely utilizing the official Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati Catholic Church Facebook and Instagram pages for building awareness of and celebrating parish related activities.

**Overall:** People acknowledged how they love to hear fellow parishioners "sharing a grace" talk about how God is working in their lives at Frassati at the conclusion of Mass. It's important for all to understand that the big vision we have as a community includes turning the parish one day into a shrine with a museum dedicated to our patron.



## Building the Good Adventure

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$1.8 million, of which \$948,039 has been collected. *When paying your pledge, please write* **capital campaign** *in the memo of your check.* 

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes an 11,000 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, a 3,000 square-foot "ad alternate" middle school wing for Seton Catholic *pending their fundraising efforts* (picture below), vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes.



## Moving Forward

The building committee is working with Santee Cooper Electric to install a street light at the corner of Silvercrest Drive and the power station for the entire development of the Frassati Parish/Seton School campus.

The diocese hired Maynard Nexsen to help finalize the Horry County drainage easement and 7.75 acres property deal for Frassati Parish. The former has been submitted to Horry County.

New sidewalks to the side entranceways to Seton School were installed. Special thanks to the De Los Santos family for providing free labor on the sidewalks project.
