



Building the Good Adventure

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$1.8 million, of which \$1,022,624 has been collected. *When paying your pledge, please write* **capital campaign** *in the memo of your check.*

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes an 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, a 3,560 square-foot "ad alternate" middle school wing for Seton Catholic *pending their fundraising efforts* (picture below), vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes.
