



Building the Good Adventure

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$1.8 million, of which \$1,031,656 has been collected. *When paying your pledge, please write* **capital campaign** *in the memo of your check.*

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes an 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, a 3,560 square-foot "ad alternate" middle school wing for Seton Catholic *pending their fundraising efforts* (picture below), vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes.



Moving Forward

Our parish and Father David have been instrumental in the Newman Center being built at Coastal Carolina. The Chapel project arrived at another milestone with the installation of a stain glass window of the Crucifixion of Jesus. Special thanks to Ron Walker for all he has done to renovate and frame the window and the church furniture he is building for the chapel.

Boudreaux Architects has finished the renderings of the conceptual master plan, the updated multipurpose building with "ad alternate" middle school wing, and the layout of Phase I of our parish campus. They also are preparing an updated cost estimate for the project (overall cost, "ad alternate" middle school wing, initial columbarium in Frassati Garden). These renderings will be on display at our May 19 celebration.
