**Holy water** will be available after all Masses. Bring your bottle back from last year to fill it up or, if you are new, we have empty holy water containers available for you to fill.

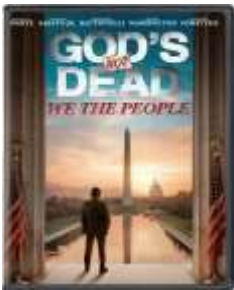

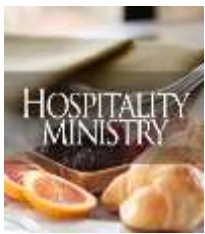

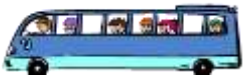
