What does “consecration” to a saint mean? “Consecrating” oneself refers to dedicating oneself and setting oneself apart for a special relationship with a saint(s). Above all, this means setting aside time to be with and talk with and learn more about and from the life of a particular saint. In other words, it’s developing a friendship with a saint and recognizing that he/she can teach us many things and intercede to God (Father, Son, & Holy Spirit) on our behalf more effectively than we can alone, because he/she is holy and “higher” than us (because they are in heaven with God and the other saints). Bishop Guglielmone has consecrated our Diocese to St. Joseph this year, which means not just asking St. Joseph to look out and intercede for us, but demands us *going to Joseph* (cf. Genesis 41:55) in the ways just described.
