## July 4<sup>th</sup> – Feast Day of our Patron Pier Giorgio Frassati

July 4 marks the feast day of Pier Giorgio Frassati, a well-known young blessed of modern times. Born on April 6, 1901 in Turin to a wealthy agnostic family, he early in life found himself drawn to the faith and serving Christ in the poor. He was particularly known for his prayer and his great love of the outdoors. He has been described by friends as **“an explosion of Joy”** - committed to the fullness of the Gospel, paying particular attention to the poor, the forgotten, and the lonely (leading Pope John Paul II to call him *The Man of the Eight Beatitudes*).

So, this 4th of July, as we wonder about the future of our country and the world, as we worry about our health, our jobs, and our families, let’s also remember to celebrate the Feast Day of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati with **“an explosion of Joy.”**
