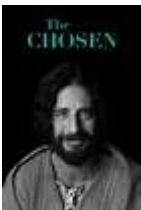
- Donations to the Grand Strand Humane Society and Conway Animal Shelter.

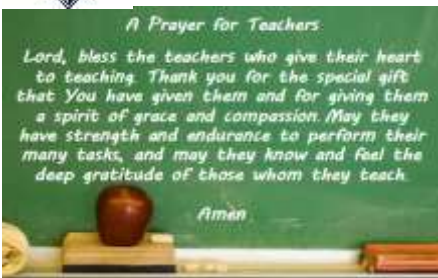
