A special blessing will be given to any food (baskets) you bring for your Thanksgiving feast at the conclusion of Mass.

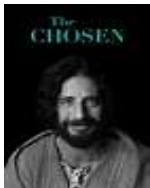

Tax Credits for Tuition

There is an updated process for **Parental Refundable Credit** applications. The SC Department of Revenue will begin accepting tax year 2021 applications on Jan. 18, 2022 at 8:30 am

- Applications must be submitted online using the free and secure tax portal MyDORWAY.
- All submission information will be entered into and processed through MyDORWAY.
- A tutorial is available to demonstrate how to submit the application through MyDORWAY: Review the TC-57A info sheet for details on the information you'll need to complete the application.
- If you already have a MyDORWAY account, test your MyDORWAY login information to make sure you can sign in on Jan. 18. If you need to create a MyDORWAY account, do so now to save time when applications open.
- Review the TC-57A info sheet for instructions. For more help using MyDORWAY, including signing up, review our tutorials at dor.sc.gov/MyDORWAY.
- To apply for the credit on Jan. 18, 2022, beginning at 8:30 a.m., follow these steps:
 - Log in to MyDORWAY at <https://dor.sc.gov/mydorway>
 - Under the Accounts tab, scroll to your Individual Income Tax account
 - Click More Account Options
 - Click Apply for Parental Refundable Credit
