1st Degree ceremony 12:00 noon November 14th, following the 11:00 am Mass. After the 1st Degree ceremony, we will have the installation of Officers.

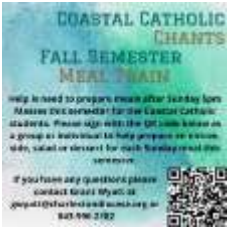

National Prayer for Dobbs

- Earlier this year, the U.S. Supreme Court agreed to accept *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*. The case addresses the constitutionality of a 15-week abortion ban passed into law in Mississippi, and it has the potential to overturn *Roe v. Wade*. Oral arguments will be held Dec. 1, and a decision is expected in June 2022.

Tax Credits for Tuition

There is an updated process for **Parental Refundable Credit** applications. The SC Department of Revenue will begin accepting tax year 2021 applications on January 18, 2022, at 8:30 am.

- Applications must be submitted online using the free and secure tax portal MyDORWAY.
- All submission information will be entered into and processed through MyDORWAY.
- A tutorial is available to demonstrate how to submit the application through MyDORWAY: Review the TC-57A info sheet for details on the information you will need to complete the application.
- If you already have a MyDORWAY account, test your MyDORWAY login information to make sure you can sign in on January 18th. If you need to create a MyDORWAY account, do so now to save time when applications open.
- Review the TC-57A info sheet for instructions. For more help using MyDORWAY, including signing up, review our tutorials at dor.sc.gov/MyDORWAY.
- To apply for the credit on Jan. 18, 2022, beginning at 8:30 a.m., follow these steps:
 - Log in to MyDORWAY at <https://dor.sc.gov/mydorway>
 - Under the Accounts tab, scroll to your Individual Income Tax account
 - Click More Account Options
 - Click Apply for Parental Refundable Credit
