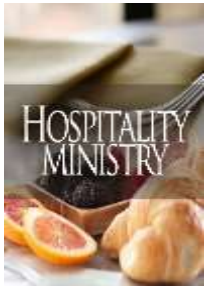

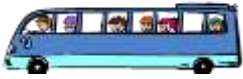

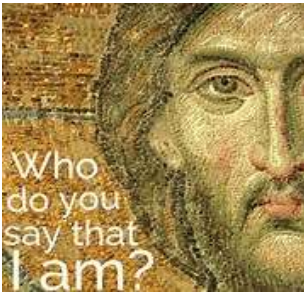
MOVIE NIGHT
