Fasting and abstinence during Lent

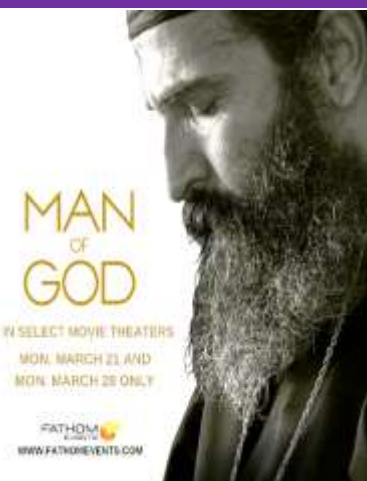
- Everyone age 14 year or older is bound to abstain from meat all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.
- Everyone age 18 or older, and under age 59, is bound to fast on Good Friday.
- On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one’s needs, but together should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
