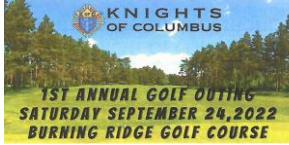
LOST AND FOUND

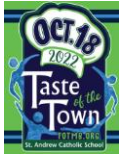

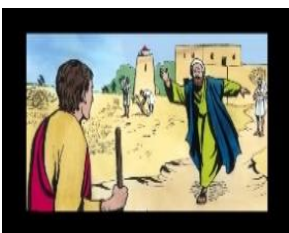
