Gino Olivero: He was a true Christian one hundred percent, a Christian who was well aware of the sense of universal brotherhood. For example, in the forge field, he knew how to treat everyone with the same friendliness, both those who were kindred by feelings, and those who possessed this affinity with him only minimally or not at all. In fact, with those with whom he felt more distant either by temperament or intelligence or social position, he preferred to deal more often, transforming the pleasure of friendship into the duty of it, a duty closely linked to the reconstructive force of universal good and justice. And precisely in terms of universal justice, he—immediately at the end of WWI, when the mere name of German provoked the most violent reactions in all the European bourgeoisie,

who were eager to show their anti-Germanism beyond the limits of the human fashion or conventional politics—approached the Germans in a fraternal spirit who, yesterday implacable enemies, today appeared to him only as defeated and suffering. **(Excerpts from La Carita, edited by Luciana Frassati, pg. 45-46)** **Weekly Challenge:** Talk to and/or pay a compliment to someone who is difficult for you to love.
