Pier Giorgio remained impressed by the sight of this young boy with an exuberant body already totally defeated by sickness. "You see," he said, "what an enormous gift it is to be in good health as we are." And a moment later he added. "Also, the deformation of this young boy will disappear when in a few years he will reach Heaven. Therefore, we have the duty of putting our health at the service of those who do not possess it. To act otherwise would be to betray this great gift of God and His benevolence."
