FRASSATI SPOTLIGHT



On Palm Sunday, Bishop Jacques Fabre-Jeune was the Celebrant at the 5pm Mass where he delivered the official proclamation of **Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati Catholic Church** and Fr. David Nerbun as the founding Pastor.

CCCF began in July 2020, with approximately 90 parishioners. Today there are close to 900.

Fr. David suggested to name the Parish after Pier Giorgio Frassati due to Frassati's "extreme ordinariness" – "he was not a priest, a pope, or worker of great miracles. He was a layman studying mining engineering."

Frassati, from an early age, exhibited unbridled selflessness and generosity, was dedicated to his faith, the Eucharist and serving Catholic youth. He was known for his athleticism and profound sense of humor. He died of

polio at the age of 24 and was beatified by St. John Paul II in 1990, who referred to the Italian as "the man of the beatitudes". Before his death, Blessed Pier Giorgio made one final mountain climb and wrote *Verso L'Alto,* "to the heights," on a photograph taken the day of the trek. He is regarded as a patron for youth and young adults.
