Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

Mass with musical accompaniment on Friday, June 16, 2023 at 5:30pm



Devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus were popularized when Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690), received visions from Jesus. He told her, "My Divine Heart is so passionately in love with humanity that it can no longer contain within itself the flames of its ardent love. It must pour them out. I have chosen you for this great plan."

From these visions, Jesus asked her to receive the Eucharist on the first Friday of the month for nine consecutive months and to make reparation through prayer to his most Sacred Heart. Pope Pius IX made it an obligatory feast throughout the universal Church in 1856. "First Friday" devotions are a beautiful way to grow closer to Christ's heart. **Oh Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in Thee**.

- Tithe for June 11 Seminarian Collection (Diocesan Required Collection for Parishes)
 Seminarian Collection will provide for the spiritual, academic and theological formation of our future priests. The
 Seminarian Fund assists men in their journey toward a lifetime of service and sacramental ministry.
 - The Diocese currently has 20 seminarians for the 2023-2024 academic year
 - Of the 20, 5 are college seminarians, 3 are pre-theologians, 12 are theologians
 - Seminary formation can take anywhere from 6-10 years of formation depending on the person
 - We currently have seminarians in Latrobe, PA, Boynton Beach, FL, Miami, FL, & Washington, DC.
 - We ordained one priest this year and 2 transitional deacons
 - The average cost to the diocese per seminarian per year is about \$46k
 - The primary sources of revenue to form seminarians comes from the Catholic Appeal of South Carolina (formerly the BAA) and the seminarian collection for this weekend. However, those sources of revenue have not kept pace with increasing number of seminarians and associated costs.

The example and vocational investment of our parish priests are indispensable in the continued growth of priestly vocations in the diocese. Please continue to invite men to consider the priesthood and contact us in the Vocations Office if we can be of any help in how to do this in the future.
