Gian Maria Bertini recalls: He could not doubt anyone and at times it took his beauty and goodness in order to recognize some exploiters of his generosity. With these he then showed great compassion and patience by not placing the entire blame for the fault on them.

He deeply felt the immorality that society nurtures in some of its layers and therefore knew how to forgive. Before those poor souls who used to market their bodies, he expressed his own regret and accused as guilty of their sins, above all, the governing bodies of society, in which every sense of Christianity had sometimes disappeared. The discussions on this subject were long and animated, in which his impetuous and sublime desire to benefit those souls and call them back to the path of goodness clearly transpired. I remember that one evening, passing by these unhappy creatures, he told me that one day he would like to gather these poor ones together, to give them the opportunity to honestly earn their living. Weekly Challenge: Rather than judge a rude person who is physically or spiritually poor, pray a decade of the rosary for them.

We tithe as a Parish! All that we have, and all that we are, comes from God. Tithing is a way of thanking God for his kindness by returning to him and others in need a portion of the time, talent, and treasure he has given us. This means we give 10% of our total weekly offertory away. We intentionally “pay it forward” to sacrifice and inspire those who have not taken that personal step in their journey of faith. Moreover, it simplifies our liturgies by avoiding multiple collections every week. Half of our weekly tithe is used for Friends of Frassati, and half goes to Diocesan or Parish chosen causes.
