



Volunteer Training Packet

The Diocese of Charleston requires that all volunteers with access to minors or vulnerable adults, that drive for the parish, or count money have additional screening/ training to comply with their Safe Environment policy.

How do I know what training I need?

1. If you have access to minors or vulnerable adults (homeless, homebound, nursing home) you need:

- Code of conduct acknowledgement : <u>Ministerial-Standards-Code-of-Conduct.pdf (charlestondiocese.org)</u>
- Background screening: <u>Background-Screening-Packet-English-2022.pdf (charlestondiocese.org)</u> pg 1-3.
- □ Safe Haven training: <u>Safe-Environment-Training-Flyer.pdf</u> (charlestondiocese.org)
- Vulnerable Adults training: 2.0-Vulnerable-Adults-eLearning-Charleston.pdf (charlestondiocese.org)
- 2. If you drive on behalf of the Parish for any reason you need:
- Completed driver application: <u>Background-Screening-Packet-English-2022.pdf (charlestondiocese.org)</u> pg 4.
- □ Submit proof of insurance (part of the application process)
- 3. If you count money for the parish you need:
- Background screening: <u>Background-Screening-Packet-English-2022.pdf (charlestondiocese.org)</u> pg. 1-3
- □ Credit authorization form: <u>Background-Screening-Packet-English-2022.pdf</u> (charlestondiocese.org) pg 5.
